

Teaching Notes - Music

Song: We are the Light

Good choice for	Spring term, Lent, Summer term, Pentecost - Any time
Starting points	 Warmups: Humming. Hum up and down the scale, raising the starting note by one step each time. Vowel sounds: Sing the different vowel sounds, 'ae-ee-eye-oh-oo' on one note, then repeat on the next note up, continuing up the scale.
Things to look out for	 The words move quite quickly so spend some time talking about how you can create a beautiful legato vocal line by elongating the vowel sounds. Make sure that the consonants are clear and exciting. Spend some time looking at the end of phrases and the words to make sure they are pronounced clearly.
Scoring / performance / instrumental suggestions	 The first verse would work with a solo voice This song would also work with unison voices The 'ah' section written as the SATB choral part could be played by a string quartet or by solo strings. At bar 46 the choir could split with one half singing the part marked 'voice' and the other singing the soprano part as the echo.
Focus / Technical focus	DictionSinging legato
Specialist language meanings	Legato - "tied together," smoothly and connected Diction - ensuring each word is heard clearly
